Monday Nov 15th Lat 61° 30' Long 32° 13'
 Comes with fresh trades squally weather saw
 a steamer going S.W. ship heading S.W. by S
 with all sail set middle part squally
 and moderate latter part good breeze
 saw killer one merchant bark in sight
 so ends

Tuesday Nov 16th Lat 81° 25' Long 32° 45'
 Comes with pleasant weather all sail set
 saw several white waters broke out
 the hole for water the same bark in
 sight middle and latter part fine weather
 picked the root potatoes found half
 rotten so ends

Wednesday Nov 17th Lat 10° 54' Long 23° 10'
 Comes with pleasant weather saw killer
 and a finback made a buder from S.W.
 middle part fresh breeze squally latter part
 good weather saw finbacks beeching one
 merchant man in sight so ends

Thursday Nov 18th Lat 13° 38' Long 33° 40'
 Comes with light winds from East all
 sail set course S.W. by S. saw large brack
 suppose to be finbacks middle and latter
 part plenty of sailing and starting so ends

Friday Nov 19th Lat 15° 21' Long 34° 04'
 Comes with light winds from N.W. quiet wind
 during Mate made a hope for the deck tub
 middle and latter part fine weather repair main

Saturday November 20th Lat 18° 30' Long 34° 31'
 Comes with fine weather saw a 5 master ship going
 South finish repair the mainsail and bent middle
 and latter part moderate wind N.W. so ends

Sunday November 21st Lat 17° 20' Long 35° 02'
 Comes with light air and calm middle part light
 breeze from N.W. latter part fresh breeze saw
 several white waters so ends

Monday Nov 22nd Lat 17° 55' Long 35° 47'
 Comes with good breeze from N.W. saw plenty
 white waters spore to be finbacks cut two
 fish on drill line at supper time Manuel Andrade
 and Cook had a fight on account of the fish that
 give him for supper sent M. Andrade to Masthead
 middle and latter part squally plenty finbacks
 beeching saw a ship going into S.E. so ends

Tuesday Nov 23rd Lat 18° 19'
 Comes with squally weather and rain
 at dark took in the foresail and set the
 fore top sail wind N.W. middle part the same
 latter part strong winds rough sea saw more
 finbacks beeching so ends

Wednesday Nov 24th Lat 18° 21' Long 36° 21'
 Comes with strong winds from N.W. rough sea
 Mate ben on is soon may ball day middle and
 latter very rough weather and hazy so ends

Thursday Nov 25th Lat 19° 30' Long 36° 33'
 Comes with strong N.W. winds rough
 smoky weather middle and latter part
 the same saw a ship going South
