Tuesday Dec 7 Lat 21:10 Long 37:20
Comes with fair weather all sail
set course S by W fix the linings
of the stove middle part fair weather latter
part the same at 12 A.M. raised Whales
lower for them S.B. struck got store by
a lone Whale second made got the Whale
so ends

Wednesday Dec 8th Lat 23:32 Long 37:40
Comes with fresh breeze quite well running
at half past noon got the Whale a long
side put cutting gear up at 2 P.M. start
cutting at 6 finish middle part good breeze
at day light raised Whales going very
quick to S.W. at 9 A.M. lower at eleven
S.B. struck at noon got the Whale fluked
so ends

Thursday Dec 9th Lat 24:17 Long 37:55
Comes with fair weather at 1 P.M. commenced
cutting at half past four got trew at 6
start the fire middle and latter part good
weather crew employed tanning blubber up
and boiling so ends

Friday Dec 10th Lat 24:48 Long 36:42
Comes with good weather crew employed
ship duty boiling and stow some oil
down middle and latter part strong
winds from N.E. to N. rough sea finish boiling
so ends

Saturday Dec 11th Lat 26:12 Long 36:50
Comes with fresh winds rough sea stow
down the rest of the oil and change water
on fresh Water Casks middle part very
rough latter part moderate down very dirty
weather so ends

Sunday Dec 12th Lat 26:40 Long 36:50
Comes with moderate winds from N.E.
thick rainy weather running S.W. by S under
Mast sail middle part found South with
heavy rain latter part fresh gale so ends

Monday Dec 13th Comes with fresh gale
wind South with rain squalls, heavy
well running ship heading on foot stake
under two by sails and staysail middle
part moderate down at day light hove
to the North and set the fore sail saw a fish

Tuesday Dec 14 Lat 26:00 Long 36:28
Comes with strong winds from South rough
squally weather middle the same latter part
fresh winds from South clear weather repair the
S.B. so ends

Wednesday Dec 15th Lat 24:20 Long 36:26
