 middle and latter part weather the same

Wednesday January 5th Lat 18:24 Long 36:12
 Comes with clear weather moderate some
 saw a steamer going S.W. broke out beef
 middle part weather the same latter part moderate
 some saw four men of war going N.E. saw
 a fireback so ends

Thursday January 6th Lat 18:28 Long 36:30
 Comes with moderate East winds heavy swell running
 spoke Italian Bark King Malcolm bound to
 St Michael for Orders is Long 37:02 which
 put us 32 miles out middle and latter part
 fair weather so ends

Friday January 7th Lat 18:09 Long 36:55
 Comes with pleasant weather repair the flying
 and set the mainsail for the second time to
 crew at 10 P.M. saw blackfish going quite
 to the west middle and latter part fair weather

 Comes with fine weather S.E. trades saw a bark
 and a steamer going S.W. middle part good
 weather latter part light airs and squally
