

Monday Feb 28th 1850
Comes with strong N.E. winds rough sea
very cloudy weather set the main sail
in the afternoon to drag middle and
latter part very strong N.E. trades rough
sea repaired the flying jib so ends

Tuesday March 1st Lat 6:03 Long 39:09
Comes with very strong trades rough sea
finish repairing the flying jib feel some
salt water on fresh water casks middle
and latter part weather the same so ends

Wednesday March 2nd Lat 7:03 Long 39:20
Comes with strong trades rough sea bent
the new jib the other stands on the head
the casks that we put on top to trim
the vessel they roll over and half the
water went out every thing ass back
wards middle and latter part weather the
same made new fenders for the top sail so ends

Thursday March 3rd Lat 7:46 Long 39:51
Comes with strong trades rough squally weather
crew employed doing some oil pores middle
weather the same latter part on bent
the main sail and repaired so ends

Friday March 4th Lat 8:46 Long 40:01
Comes with strong trades rough weather
crew employed repairing the main sail
ship heading N.E. under foresail and
jib and staysail and trysail middle
and latter part very rough so ends

Saturday March 5th Lat 9:32 Long 40:20
Comes with fresh trades at sun set moderate
some middle and latter part fresh trades
squally so ends

Sunday March 6th Lat 10:30 Long 40:30
Comes with fresh trades set the main sail
and flying jib at half past 5 P.M. raised
a big whale but come dark before the whale
came up again middle and latter part good
weather so ends

Monday March 7th Lat 10:42 Long 40:34
Comes with pleasant weather working up to the
Eastward but could not find the whale at
1 P.M. stood to North all lower sails set middle
part moderate latter part good breeze saw a
finback so ends

Tuesday March 8th Lat 11:47 Long 40:45
Comes with fresh trades pleasant weather at sun
set take ship to S.E. all lower sails set middle
part squally latter part fresh trades broke out water
and flow so ends

Wednesday March 9th Lat 12:58 Long 40:25
Comes with fresh trades smoky weather saw porpoise
at sun set shortened sail middle part moderate
latter part good weather ship cruising ground clean
so ends

Thursday March 10th Lat 13:40 Long 40:47
Comes with light trades with light rain
squalls at sun set shortened sail and
lay to S.E. middle part squally latter part
fine weather so ends

Friday March 11th Lat 13:28 Long 40:26
Comes with light trades fine weather saw
humpbacks middle and latter part light
breeze clear weather crew employed in
ship duty so ends
