Comes with fair weather nothing but clear
water repair the old jib middle part
weather the same at 2 P.M. saw black fish
lower for them got one and lost another so

Sunday March 27th Lat 13:30 Long 41:10
Comes with fair weather at half past
noon raised White Water soon after
made out to be Whales lower got the
one to each boat 2 good calves and small
Whale at 4 P.M. got them along side
and cut one in middle part good breeze
at day light commence cutting at 8 A.M. finish and
clear the heads up

Monday March 28th Lat 13:51 Long 41:45
Comes with pleasant weather light N.E.
trades at P.M. start the works middle and
latter part fresh trades crew employed
boiling and getting barks ready for oil so ends

Tuesday March 19th Lat 13:14 Long 41:18
Comes with good trades clear weather at
8 P.M. finish boiling turned up a barrel
of Oil middle and latter part fresh breeze blow
the oil down so ends so ends

Wednesday March 30th Lat 13:38 Long 41:20
Comes with pleasant weather beat the old foresail
middle and latter fine weather Made Side lights boxes
so ends

Thursday March 31st Lat 13:40 Long 41:52
Comes with light trades very fine weather broke out
Beef middle and latter part fine weather
crew employed in ship duty so ends

Friday April 1st Lat 12:48 Long 41:42
Comes with pleasant weather light trades
put a new rope on leach of the foresail
the other give out at sunset short sail
middle part weather moderate latter part light breeze
all sail set working westward so ends

Saturday April 2nd Lat 13:09 Long 42:12
Comes with breeze from S.E. at 5 P.M. took in the
main sail to sew the leach rope and set the main
top sail steering course to night middle and latter
part light winds from S.E. so ends

Sunday April 3rd Lat 13:44 Long 43:14
Comes with light trades from S.E. all sail set
steering N by E. Made a piece to go on fore
boom struck a big Albacore fixed the
lance line and lost the Iron middle and latter
weather the same so ends

Monday April 4th Lat 12:55 Long 44:51
Comes with moderate trades all sail set working
Westward saw porpoise course N.W. middle
and latter part rain squalls main sail burst 9 cloths crew so ends

Tuesday April 5th Lat 13:19 Long 46:39
Comes with squally weather wind N.E. saw a Seta going
in to NW course N.W. foresail and top sail and main top sail
middle part squally latter part fresh trades repaired the
main sail so ends

Comes with fresh trades course N.W. middle and latter
part weather the same crew employed in ship duty so ends
