 part S.S.E. so explaining in ship
 duty so end latitude 31.37 lang 56.11

Tuesday 17

the day with strong South winds and
 vessail lay to under 2 traisails and
 2 paid sail so explaining in ship
 duty so end latitude 31.56 lang 53.43

Wednesday 18

the day with strong breeze from sea
 and Rein vessail under shot sail
 winds from South later part
 winds hold from NW. so end
 latitude 31.48 lang 51.40

Thursday 19

the day winds from NW. light
 with ease sea vessail under shot
 sail hauling S.E. so end the day
 latitude 31.48 lang 51.34

Friday 20

the day with fine weather winds from
 NW and vessail hauling E by S. so
 explaining in ship duty so end
 latitude 31.41 lang 50.20

 sight so end the day
 latitude 32.30 lang 49.25

Monday 23

the day with strong breeze from SW
 with ease sea at 8 a.m. winds
 hold from North vessail under
 2 traisails and fore star sail so end
 latitude 32.50 lang 49.20

Tuesday 24

the day with light good breeze from
 NW. and vessail hauling NW by W
 under all sail all day so end
 latitude 32.44 lang 51.40

Wednesday 25

the day with fine weather winds
 from NW vessail hauling NW under
 all sail Cruzzing Rend and saw
 one steamer and being Reapening
 Olan jebi so end the day
 latitude 33.08 lang 52.47
