 latitude 34.00 lang 48.00

 the day with winds from SW and seen
 Saw Schooner John R. manta with
 boat down and I got one whale
 So lay under shot sail So end
 latitude 33.45 lang 48.24

Friday 8
 the day with fine weather light breeze
 and calm at daylight Baise Skull Bould
 and Grap the boat and L.B. Shuck the
 whale and bill them being long suit
 one maezi by peter in S.B. and cutting
 the whales fineseh at 3 p.m.
 Schooner John R. manta in Sait So end the
 day latitude 33.37 lang 48.30

 Schooner John R. manta then gut the
 whale So end the day lat 33.40 lang 48.50

 the day latitude 33.39 lang 48.56

Tuesday 12
 the day with calm and light winds vessel
 under shot sail Saw 1 Barb 2 Schooner
 So end the day latitude 33.35 lang 48.43

Wednesday 13
 the day with light breeze from west and
 made all Sails Saw 3 Schooner So nothing
 Round So end the day latitude 33.55 lang 48.20

 the day with light winds and calm
 at daylight made all Sails and
 Saw 2 Schooner So end the day
 latitude 33.53 lang 48.24
