fore or boat got to whals so or boat
Came back going so end the day

Sunday 7
the day with light winds at daylight
made all sails, heading to East Cuzco
Road saw one Cachas at sundown
shot sails so end the day
latitude 34.23 long 46.33

Monday 8
the day with wind from SW and at
daylight made sails and latter part
squally saw one sail so end the day
latitude 34.27 long 45.17

Tuesday 9
the day with winds from SW and made
all sail saw Schaner Camero and Spout
Schaner Carleton Bell sailing so end
the day latitude 34.53 long 43.03

Wednesday 10
the day with winds from SW at daylight
made sun sail and Cuzco Road
Schaner Carleton Bell in Sait so end
the day latitude 34.13 long 44.31

Thursday August 11 the 1910
the day with strong breeze from west
and squally seen one sea vessel under
shot sails at 6 a.m. saw whals going
to East Cuzco beneath one desert house
the boat Schaner Carleton bell in
Sait so end the day latitude 34.36 long 44.35

Friday 12
the day with strong breeze from East
vessel under shot sails saw Carleton bell
so end the day latitude 34.32 long 44.48

Saturday 13
the day with winds from SE. Boat
saw the sails Carleton bell in Sait
so end the day latitude 34.37 long 44.54

Sunday 14
the day with light winds and squally
all day vessel under shot sails so end the day
latitude 34.58 long 44.48

Monday 15
the day with fine weather and at daylight
made all sail stand to SE. and at sunset
shot sails so end the day
latitude 34.35 long 43.43

Tuesday 16
first part the day with calm in latter
part light breeze at 3 p.m. Beid
S.B. Small small whals and drop 3 boat
and by S.B. got fast and S.B. got fast
S.B. got 2 and S.B. got one in ~~tent~~
~~off~~ Cuff so bring them long Sait
Reamerid over night so end
the day latitude 34.18 long 43.38
