October 19 This day begins with fair weather light winds from south tower under all sail first on one tack then the other men in play in ship duty made two blocks so ends this day

October 20 This day begins with clear weather light breeze tower under all sail beating south men in play in small jobs as to ship duty nothing in sight so ends

October 21 This day begins with fair weather tower under all sail staving south south west men in play in small jobs as to ship duty nothing in sight so ends
Lat 30 Long 2454

October 22 This day begins with fair weather until 3 pm cloudy tower under all sail staving south by west wind from south west men in play in ship duty so ends
Lat 2820 South Long 2419

October 23 tower under all sail staving south south west at 8 am rain so ends at 3 pm light west wind men in play in ship duty so ends Lat 2630 Long 24

October 24 This day begins with clear weather light breeze tower under all sail staving south west by south one half south in play in repairing the old Jib top sail so ends this day

October 25 This day begins with fair weather tower under all sail staving south south west in play in repairing the old Jib top sail men in play in ship duty gaining back weather at 4 30 pm cloudy at 7 light rain so ends
Lat 23 Long 2341

October 26 This day begins with fair weather tower under all sail staving south west by south light wind from north east in play in over hauling cutting jare making new straps men in play in ship duty so ends
Lat 2150 Long 2340

October 27 This day begins with fair weather tower under all sail staving south west by south half south men in play in small jobs as to ship duty north east winds so ends this day
Lat 2012 Long 2430

October 28 This day begins with fair weather this day tower under all sail men in play in ship duty raise land at 3 pm shorting sail at 7 pm hove to of the east of St Vincent 10 30 pm so ends

October 29 This day begins with fair weather a river at St Vincent at 7 am boat went on shore at 8 am came on board at 4 30 pm hove at 5 pm all sail out staving south by west so ends this day

the two men came on board in St Vincent as crew
