Thursday December 29 this day begins with cloudy weather heavy sea fresh wind from east tower short sail heading N 6 men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight so ends

Friday December 30 this day begins with fair weather light breeze from S to tower under all sail first on one tack than the other at 3 pm fresh wind men in play in ship's duty 20 ends 4 30 pm lower no chance going quick home to under short sail heading 112 20 ends this day

Saturday December 31 this day begins with cloudy weather heavy sea tower under all lower sails wind south east men in play in ship's duty shorting sail at 7 pm have to heading south by east no sight latitude south Long West so ends

January first 1911 this day begins with clear weather calm tower under all lower sail took in main sail 9 am fore sail 2 pm set it at 4 pm light rain from south east one steamer in sight men in play in ship's duty fore sail and head sail out heading N 6 so ends Lat 34 16 Long 49 37

Sunday January 2 1911

this day begins with clear weather calm all day until 7 pm light breeze from east in play in shushing mass and serapeing of the out side of the ship and other Fals as to ship's duty nothing in sight so ends this day tower under short sail heading N 6 Lat 34 17 Long 48 39

January 3rd this day begins with clear weather tower under all sail 12 am fresh breeze took in main sail rais 20 ends 1 pm lower got 3 two boats stove sh 2 sh 1 got a long side sh at 5 pm strong breeze raged 3 20 ends a long side have to under fore sail stay sail and main try sail men in play in ship's duty so ends
Lat 34 04 Long 49 22

January 4th this day begins with a blue tower under short sail begin to blow at 1 am at 3 am ship the chances an let the whales go but the fore sail men in play in ship's duty repair two boats saw whales at 4 30 pm to ruff wind off 4 30 so ends

Thursday January 5 this day begins with cloudy weather tower under all sail stairing N 6 by 8 wind S 6 in play in making pluke waps and other Fals as to ship's duty at 6 pm took in main sail and two Fals nothing in sight men in play in ship's duty so ends
Lat 33 25 Long 48 40

Friday January 6 this day begins with cloudy weather fresh breeze tower under fore sail head sail and main try sail stairing N 6 have to at 8 am men in play in ship's duty 9 am sch carlinton bell 4 pm in play in small Fals as to ship's duty so ends
