Thursday January 19 this day begins with fair weather light wind from S.E. tower under all sail 9 am calm 2 pm light winds men in play in ship duty staving N.E. by E one half east nothing in sight so ends this day

Friday January 20 this day begins with calm from 9 30 am till 8 am light breeze from N.E. 3 pm steamer comes as going to Laredo men in play in ship duty rais whales at 12 30 am going quick lower two boats no chance got a long side 5 pm so ends

Saturday January 21 this day begins with clear weather light wind from North tower under all sail heading E N.E. men in play in ship duty shifting water and small subs as to ship duty at 2 pm calm took in all sail raining so ends

Sunday January 22 this day begins with calm at 9 am light wind from N. tower under all sail heading E N.E. men in play in ship duty one steamer in sight so ends this day

Monday January 23 this day begins with cloudy weather light wind from North tower under all sail heading N.E. by E men in play in ship duty nothing in sight so ends

this day begins with cloudy weather light wind from N. heavy sea from N.E. tower under all sail staving N.E. by E at 4 pm light rain calm wind shift S.E. staving N.E. by E all sail out but main sail men in play in ship duty so ends this day

Wednesday January 25 this day begins with cloudy weather light rain tower under all sail wind N. N.E. heading east by South one sail in sight men in play in ship duty light winds heavy seas so ends this day
Lat 26 33 Long 39 47

Thursday January 26 this day begins with cloudy weather fresh breeze from N.E. tower under all sail shorting sail 8 am staving E one sail in sight men in play in ship duty rope in on flying Jib parted took in main sail 8 pm so ends
Lat 26 34 Long 38 29

Friday January 27 this day begins with cloudy weather fresh winds from N.E. tower under all sail staving east by E men in play in ship duty reparing Jib top sail and small subs as to ship duty so ends
Lat 26 30 Long 37 29

Saturday January 28 this day begins with clear weather tower under all sail staving north men in play in ship duty nothing in sight at 4 pm made out in play in small subs as to ship duty so ends
Lat 26 05 Long 37 19

Sunday January 29 this day begins with clear weather tower under all sail first on one tack than the other rais whales 11 30 am lower 12 at 12 am gatt a long side at 3 cut in till dark love it a long side till morning nothing in sight so ends
