after supper all the fore main hands refuse to
com on deck to take there watch they would
not turn to untill 5-30 am ~~the~~ ^{on} Sunday 30

Monday January 30 this day begins with
fair weather in play in cutting finish at 11
30 am lost the case chain parted made
fire at 3 pm men in play in ship's duty took
in main sail and outer Jibs at sun set
so ends this day Lat. South Long 40

Tuesday January 31 this day begins with clear
weather light winds veering from east to
NNE tower under all tower sails but the
fore sail in play in hauling and shifting water
men in play in ship's duty nothing in sight
so ends Lat. S Long 40

Wednesday February first this day begins with
fair weather wind E of N tower under all
sail but fore sail hauling and stowing down
finish hauling 2 pm set fore sail men in play in
ship's duty first on one tack then the other so ends
Lat. 25-00 Long 38-10

Thursday February 2 this day begins with
fair weather fresh winds from ENE
tower under all sail heading ESE
finish stow down 12 am men in play
in ship's duty nothing in sight so ends
Lat 25-35 Long 37-20

Friday February 3rd this day begins with
cloudy weather fresh breeze tower
under all sail reef the main sail at
6 am wind ENE splice the Jib top
sail - 5 to and set it up men in play
in ship's duty so ends Lat 25-36 Long 36-20

Saturday Feb 4th 1911
this day begins with fair weather light wind
from NNE tower under all sail steering
east by North men in play in ship's duty
nothing in sight so ends this day
Lat 25-40 Long 34-44

Sunday Feb 5 this day begins with cloudy weather rain
light wind calm at 4 pm tower under all
sail heading from east by north to east by
south men in play in ship's duty calm at 8 pm
nothing in sight so ends this day
Lat 25-38 Long 33-45

Monday Feb 6 this day begins with clear
weather light wind from NNE tower
under all sail heading to the north at 7
pm tack heading east NNE men in play
in ship's duty nothing in sight so ends
Lat 25-14 Long 33-44

Tuesday Feb 7 this day begins with fair
weather light wind from NNE tower
under all sail gam sek mistick made all sail
heading NNE by E men in play in ship's duty
nothing in sight no sight Lat S Long 37

Wednesday Feb 8 this day begins with clear
weather this day tower under all sail
steering east NNE gaming mistick men in
play in ship's duty at 4 pm all sail out
steering NNE nothing in sight so ends
Lat 24-00 Long 32-50

Thursday Feb 9 this day begins with
fair weather light wind of NNE tower
under all sail steering NNE by E men in
play in ship's duty mistick in sight at noon
light rain so ends Lat 23-20 Long 32-19
