finish receiving provisions leave port
at 3 pm men in play in ship duty so ends

Sunday Apr 23 this day Turner under
all sail - staving N by W one half W
men in play in ship duty nothing in
sight light winds from east so ends
Lat 19 30 Long 64 17

Monday April 24 this day Turner under all
sail - staving N by W one half W. this
day in play in repairing fore top so
men in play in ship duty light
wind from east so ends this day
Lat 21 12 Long 65 17

Tuesday Apr 25 this day begins with
clear weather light winds this day
Turner under all sail - staving N by W
one half W in play in mending flying stay
sail men in play in ship duty so ends
Lat 22 27 Long 65 58

Wednesday Apr 26 this day begins with
clear weather Turner under all sail light
breeze men in play in ship duty at 12 am
wind shift to North squally strong
wind Jib top sail stay parted shorting
sail at 5 pm hatches baling down so ends
no sight

Thursday Apr 27 this day begins with
cloudy weather strong N by E winds rough
turner under short sail staving N by W
men in play in ship duty one steamer
in sight so ends this day
Lat 22 27 Long 68 22

Friday Apr 28

this day begins with cloudy weather
strong breeze from N by E Turner under all
sail staving N by W half W set the Jib
top sail stay up at 5 pm men in play
in ship duty nothing in sight so ends this day
Lat 23 57 Long 70 00

Saturday Apr 29 this day begins with clear
weather light winds from N by E Turner under
all sail - staving N by W one half W
men in play in ship duty one steamer in
sight going south east so ends this day
Lat 27 50 Long 71 18

Sunday Apr 30 this day begins with
clear weather light winds from east
this day Turner under all sail - staving
N by W men in play in ship duty
saw the steamer Molania going south
so ends Lat 22 27 Long 72 08

Monday May first 1911 this day begins
with fair weather light winds from
south west Turner under all sail
staving N by W men in play in
ship duty three men sick so ends this day
Lat 31 04 Long 72 40

Tuesday May 2 this day begins with cloudy
weather strong south west winds this
day Turner under all sail till 11 am
shorting sail staving N by E squally
men in play in ship duty no sight so ends

Wednesday this day begins with cloudy
weather squally strong wind from N by E
Turner under short sail at 5 30 pm set
the main sail heading N by W men
in play in ship duty so ends no sight

Turner runs to 1000 sick on 29
