

Thursday May 4 1911

this day begins with cloudy weather fresh wind from NW tower under all sail took in main sail 9 am set it at 3 pm rais whales going quick tower lb got one made all sail starting North men in play in ship duty so ends Lat 36 10 Long 73 48

Friday May 5th this day begins with cloudy weather tower under all sail home to at 6 am and cut in made all sail again sand whales going quick to no show for them begin to bail at 7 pm so ends this day Lat 36 18 Long 73 50

Saturday May 6th this day begins with cloudy weather fresh breeze this day tower under all sail first on one tack than the other sand whales lost sight of them going quick finish bail at 10 am men in play in ship duty so ends Lat 36 35 Long 73 42

Sunday May 7th this day begins with cloudy weather fresh breeze from NW this day tower under short sail made all lower sail at 2 pm men in play in ship duty three steamers in sight shorting sail at sun set so ends this day Lat 36 40 Long 73 40

Monday May 8th this day begins with cloudy weather strong NW winds home to under fore and main try sail and fore stay sail at 3 am bating down the hatches at 5 am rain squalls at 8 am wind shift to SW at 10 am calm heavy seas men in play in ship duty so ends this day Lat 36 55 Long 73 47

Tuesday May 9

this day begins with cloudy weather light breeze from NW tower under all sail Rais whales lower got three lb one show lb one got a long side at 5 pm men in play in ship duty so ends this day Lat 36 53 Long 73 16

Wednesday 10 this day begins with smoky weather light winds from NW in play in cutting finish at 12 am spoke tarpe do late bailing from Norfolk 20 pairs whales at 4 pm lb got one got a long side at 8 pm so ends this day Lat 36 48 Long 72 45

Thursday May 11 this day begins with smoky weather calm tower under short sail in play in cutting and bailing men in play in ship duty nothing in sight so ends Lat 36 51 Long 72 39

Friday May 12 this day begins with smoky weather bailing rais whales at 5 am lower lb got one got a long side at 11 am finish cutting at 1.30 am men in play in ship duty nothing in sight so ends this day Lat 36 57 Long 72 11

Saturday May 13 this day begins with thick weather tower under short sail finish bailing at 7 am made all sail at 8 am finish stow down at 4 pm men in play in ship duty nothing in sight shorting sail at sun set so ends Lat 36 53 Long 71 58

Sunday May 14 this day begins with thick fog at 2 am clear up at 10 am made all sail first on one tack than the other men in play in ship duty three steamers in sight so ends this day Lat 36 50 Long 72 41
