this day begins with cloudy weather. Towner under all lower sails took them in at 7.30 am fresh N^W winds where ship at 10 am stood to the north men in play in ship duty one sail in sight foggy all day so ends this day

Sunday May 28th this day begins with thick fog. Towner under short sail heading to the east men in play in ship duty at 11 am steamer Albanacia run cross and sturn with in a ship's length at 3 pm cleared of shorting sail heading North sends Lat 37 Long 73 41

Monday May 29 this day begins with smoky weather light breeze Towner under all sail. at 2 pm calm shush masts repair the fore sail men in play in ship duty so ends this day
Lat 36 43 Long 73 09

Tuesday May 30th this day begins with clear weather calm in play in small boats as to ship's duty at 3 pm light breeze made all sail heading South shorting sail at 7 pm three sch in sight and one steamer so ends this day
Lat 36 53 Long 72 59

Wednesday May 31st this day begins with clear weather light breeze Towner under all sail gaming sch margratt men in play in ship duty. Vais whales at 5 pm going quick Towner no chance so ends this day
Lat 36 50 Long 72 45

Thursday June 1st this day begins with clear weather Towner under all sail men in play in ship duty 4 sch in sight gaming sch grozer in play in small boats as to ship's duty so ends

Friday June 2 1911

this day begins with clear weather fresh breeze sch Towner under all sail first on one tack then the other at 4 pm calm one sch in sight men in play in ship duty shorting sail at 7 pm heading to the N^W sends Lat 37 17 Long 72 15

Thursday May 3rd this day begins with fair weather light breeze this day Towner under all sail heading west men in play in ship duty two sch in sight one cutter two steamers shorting sail at 2 pm so ends Lat 36 57 Long 72 29

Sunday June 4th this day begins with cloudy weather this day Towner under all sail running to the N^W fore sail and main try sail and head sail out two sch in sight men in play in ship duty three steamers sends Lat 36 55 Long 72 31

Monday June 5 this day begins with fair weather Towner under all sail starting 8 45 light winds at 1 pm variable wind calm took in main sail and top sails at 3 pm fog men in play in ship duty three sch in sight so ends Lat 37 05 Long 73 00

Tuesday June 6 this day begins with cloudy weather light breeze Towner under all sail at 6 am fog cleared at 8 am five sails in sight men in play in ship duty at 5 pm fog one sail in sight wind variable shorting sail heading N^W so ends
Lat 37 05 Long 73 30

Wednesday June 7 this day begins with cloudy weather light wind from east Towner under all sail first on one tack then the other gam sch swift and barge hurether men in play in ship duty no sight so ends this day
