This day begins with cloudy weather light breeze. Turner under all sail at 12 am at 2 pm thick fog men in play in ship duty finish stand at 4 pm nothing in sight 50 ends

Monday June 19 this day begins with cloudy weather Turner under all sail men in play in ship duty nothing in sight shorting sail at 4 pm one sail in sight at 6 pm hove to under fore and main try sail heading N N W 50 ends

Tuesday June 20 this day begins with cloudy weather light breeze Turner under all sail rais whales at 6 30 am lower sb got one small one got along side at 9 am cut in made fire at 2 pm men in play in ship duty barque further in sight and three mass sch 50 ends

Wednesday June 21 this day begins with clear weather light breeze rais whales lower at 6 30 am got a long side at 2 pm sb got one man in play in ship duty lower again 6 pm no sight made fire 8 pm further in sight hauling 50 ends finish hauling 6 am

Thursday June 22 this day begins with fair weather finish hauling at 8 am made all sail men in play in ship duty finish stowing at 4 pm spoke a fore mass sch shorting sail at sun set hove to under fore sail main try sail stay sail 50 ends

Friday June 23 this day begins with cloudy weather good breeze Turner under all sail rais whales going quick lower at 6 am got a long side at 2 pm sb chance shorting sail at 4 pm

Saturday June 24

this day begins with fog Turner under all sail at 8 am clear up at 2 pm fog again shorting sail at 3 30 pm clear at 4 pm fog lower at 7 30 got along side 8 pm sb got one wh struck iron draw hove to heading E S E 50 ends no sight

Sunday June 25 this day begins with cloudy weather cut in finish at 4 am made fire Turner under all sail but the fore sail heading N W wind W S W shorting sail at 7 pm head W finish hauling at 8 pm better in sight 50 ends no sight

Monday June 26 this day begins with cloudy weather light rain fresh S W winds Turner under all sail first on one tack than the other men in play in ship duty shorting sail at 9 pm heading W 50 ends this day

Tuesday June 27 this day begins with cloudy weather Turner under all sail men in play in ship duty sch sling swift in sight another man sick manual unread and magnal rose lower shorting sail at 3 pm heading W S W 50 ends

Wednesday June 28 this day begins with fair weather Turner under all sail rais whales at 3 30 lower sb got one got along side sun set men in play in ship duty swift in sight 50 ends this day
Lat 36 34 Long 73 26

Thursday June 29 this day begins with light breeze in play in cutting rais whales at 6 am lower two boats sb got one and lb one got a long side at 12 am cut in made fire at 4 pm under short sail hauling two sch in sight 50 ends
