weather strong south west winds tower
under short sail took in flying jib at 12
am at 2 pm reef the fore sail at 6 pm took
it in and set fore try sail still shorting
so ends Lat 37 07 Long 73 44

Tuesday July 25 this day begins with cloudy
weather strong breeze tower under short sail
ruft at 12 am calm and heavy sea at
4 pm moderate three sail in sight men
in play in ship duty hove to fore and main
sail and jib fore stay sail so ends
Lat 37 07 Long 74 00

Wednesday July 26 this day begins with
cloudy weather fresh wind from east
tower under short sail made all sail
8 am moderate a little men in play in
duty 6 sails in sight gain 8 sch mickerson
at 5 pm shorting sail at
7 pm so ends

Thursday July 27 1911

this day begins with cloudy weather tower
under all sail men in play in ship duty at 2 pm
rain squalls fresh wind from N^E shorting
sail at 3 pm have to under day sail and jib
heading north so ends this day
Lat 36 37 Long 73 49

Friday July 28 this day begins with
cloudy weather heavy sea from south east
tower under short sail calm gain to
hearth a men in play in ship duty short
in sail at 7 pm took in fore sail so ends
Lat 36 40 Long 74 06

Saturday July 29 this day begins with
calm until 12 am made all sail
light breeze from N^E men in play
in ship duty gaining back hearth a car
rying all sail to night stearing N^E
so ends Lat 36 28 Long 74 48

Sunday July 30 this day begins with
cloudy weather calm tower under all sail
men in play in ship duty gaining 8
a.m. mickerson and William groper at
6 pm light winds from S^E south east all
sail out stearing N^E so ends
Lat 36 36 Long 74 06

Monday July 31 this day begins with
clear and calm weather tower under
all sail men in play in ship duty
at 5 am scraping and so on put a band
a round the & under head shorting
sail at sun set heading N^E at
three sails in sight so ends this day
Lat 36 43 Long 73 29
