this day begins with fair weather calm at 9 am light breeze from East made all sail first on one tack than the other at 7 pm heading N E all sail out men in play in ship duty scraping and soon so ends this day

Wednesday Aug 2 this day begins with clear weather light breeze from East under all sail first one tack than the other men in play in small boats as to ship duty five sails in sight at 7 pm took in topsail heading N E so ends this day Lat 37 10 Long 72 56

Thursday Aug 3 this day begins with fair weather calm at 12 am light wind from East under all sail men in play in small boats as to ship duty at 4 pm gaming carling bell starting sail heading N E so ends this day Lat 37 15 Long 73 00

Friday Aug 4 this day begins with clear weather light wind from east all sail out men in play in ship duty 4 sch in sight at 7 pm took in topsails heading N E so ends this day Lat 37 18 Long 73 00

Saturday Aug 5 this day begins with fair weather light wind from SE under all sail out took in the fore and main topsail heading N E by 8 men in play in ship duty so ends this day Lat 37 36 Long 72 44

Sunday Aug 6 1911

this day begins with clear weather light easterly winds under all sail starting N E men in play in ship duty one steamer in sight one barge and sch so ends this day Lat 38 40 Long 72 34

Monday Aug 7 this day begins with cloudy weather under all sail out first on one tack than the other at 8 pm tack to the north heading N E by 8 men in play in ship duty one sail and steamer in sight so ends this day Lat 39 36 Long 72 37

Tuesday Aug 8 this day begins with clear weather light wind from east N E under all sail men in play in dashing ship and other boats as to ship duty at 7 pm light breeze from South all sail out starting N E so ends this day Lat 39 48 Long 72 41

Wednesday Aug 9 this day begins with clear weather under all sail starting N E men in play in ship duty at 4 pm broke out chains anchor all bend on at 5 pm spoke side mast sch Wyandott of Boston so ends this day Lat 40 40 Long East

Thursday Aug 10 this day begins with thick fog under all sail men in play in ship duty at 8 am calm at 4 pm light wind from S W starting east N E at 9 pm rais gay head light at 11 30 a breast the light ship so ends this day
