come with good breeze first part latter calm we anchor at- Dominica harbor 330 a.m. at day light Broke out- East fuel with water so to lay ship on side to be repair 3 men from shore working all day take out copper on side of ship to find the trouble of make water

light- air from all directions employed on various ~~part~~ job anchor at- Dominica harbor
