the day with light winds and squally
from S.E. and vessel under all sails
lat 23.55 long 25.43

Monday 7
the day with winds from S.E. and
heading South in W under all
sails so end lat 22.15 long 25.39

Thursday 8
the day with strong breeze from E.S.E.
vessel heading S. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W
lat 20.20 long 24.40

Wednesday 9
the day with strong breeze and clear
at 2 p.m. Rain Ireland off S. t. antonia
so end lat 17.30. long 25.01

Thursday October 10
the day with strong breeze from S.E. at
Sun set lowering S. t. antonia and
Brava so end

Monday October 21
we left Brava with winds
from N.E. so end the day

Thursday 22 with winds from
N.E. vessel under all sails at 3 p.m.
Rais four whals and Drap 3 boat
Chasse them whals going quickly
to winds so boat came broad going
so end the day lat (14.00) 24.47

Wednesday 23
the day with winds from N.E. under
all sails heading S. by W. so end
lat 12.21 long 24.42

Thursday 24
the day with light winds and squally
vessel heading S. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W so end
saw one sail

Friday 25
the day with calm and light breeze
squally Reen vessel under all sails
heading S. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ so end
lat 9.00 long 24.44

the day with light winds and calm
and squally so lat 7.37 long 24.57
