the day with light breeze and calm
made all sails shot down sun beat
Carleton Bell in sight lat 32.45) 47.47

Wednesday 15
the day with light winds and calm
made all up her sails at sundown
shot sails going lat 33.27. long 48.20

Thursday 16
the day with fine weather and made
all sails at 7. AM. Saw small
whals and got boat down west boat
got fresh small whals and Deast
went off with 80 boat came back
nothing there
lat 33.35 long 48.40

Friday 17
the day strong breeze fresh hailing
Reefing S.B. Stood down the oil
lat 33.55 long 48.77

Saturday 18
the day with calm but weather
light breeze so end

Sunday January 19 the 1913
the day with calm and light winds
lat 33.40. long 48.51

Monday 20
the day with light winds at daylight
made all sails and at sundown shot
sails going lat 33.33. long 48.23

Tuesday 21
the day with strong breeze from SW
vessels under shot sails heading to
Port so end the day lat 33.07 long 46.34

Wednesday 22
the day with calm and fair sea vessels
under shot sails lat 32.25. long 46.18

Thursday 23
the day with light winds and calm
made all her sails sun down shot
sails saw one sail lat 32.06. long 45.67

Friday 24
the day with light winds made all sails
the heavy main sails going
lat 31.25 long 44.49

Saturday 25
the day with winds from SW and
sprits. Barks. morning Star so
lat 30.30 long 44.30
morning Star long 45.32

Sunday 26
the day with winds from south
and vessels under all her sails
lat 30.05 long 43.44
