 the day with winds from E.W. and
 at daylight made sun sails Crugging
 Spouty Steamer lat 33.17 long 41.05

Thursday 21
 the day with light winds and calm
 at daylight made sails
 Crugging lat 33.12 long 40.21

Friday August 22nd 1913
 the day with light winds and calm
 saw Schoner pedor varala
 so end lat 33.20 long 39.55

Saturday 23
 the day with light winds and calm
 beat all sails Schoner pedor in suit
 lat 33.33 long 39.40

Sunday 24
 the day with light winds and vessels
 under all sails winds from E.S.
 lat 34.10 long 39.28

Monday 25
 the day with strong breeze from
 E.S. vessels hauling S. by E. under all
 sails lat 33.12 long 38.48

Thursday 26
 the day with light winds from E.S.
 and vessels under all sails
 lat 33.13 long 38.18

Wednesday 27
 the day with winds from E.W. and
 vessels hauling by the winds under
 all sails lat 32.53 long 37.12

Thursday 28
 the day with squally weather winds
 from E.S. vessels by the winds
 lat 32.40 long 36.20

Friday 29
