56 Very strong NE wind at 4 P.M.  
when point of St. Antoine Bearing  
South dist 3 miles. Found the  
Waltham Chronometer to be 18 miles  
to the westward. Rated it  
and stood by the wind on the  
Starboard Tack Pump and lights  
attended to So ends this day

57 Thursday Dec 25-1913

This day Moderate East wind  
Christmas Nothing doing.  
Pump and lights attended to  
Lat  $18^{\circ}10' N$   
Long  $25^{\circ}56' W$

58 Friday Dec 26-1913

Light East wind with a heavy  
swell. Watch employed Picking over  
onions Pump and lights attended to  
So ends this day  
Lat  $19^{\circ}13' N$   
Long  $26^{\circ}04' W$

59 Sat Dec 27-1913

Begins with a Moderate gale from East  
Vessel under Spruce Fore Stay sail  
and jib Pump and lights attended to  
Later Part Calm. So ends this day  
Lat  $19^{\circ}25' N$   
Long  $26^{\circ}21' W$

60 Sunday Dec 28-1913

Moderate wind from ESE Vessel  
Cruising for whales Watch employed  
at Ship's duty Pump and lights  
attended to So ends this day  
Lat  $20^{\circ}11' N$   
Long  $26^{\circ}25' W$

61 Monday Dec 29-1913

Moderate SE Breeze Vessel Cruising
