63 Wednesday Dec 31 - 1913

Very light air from NE Vessel  
cruising for whales Pumps and  
lights attended to So ended this day  
Lat  $20^{\circ}34' N$   
Long  $26^{\circ}04' W$

64 Thursday Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 1914

Begins with a very light east breeze  
at 9 am A lone sperm was raised  
by Mr Gilbert. Whale going NW. Lowered  
three boats at 9:45 am LB struck  
the whale. Got it along side at 1 PM  
Cut in the body and left the head  
along side over night. Pumps and lights  
attended to So ended this day

65 Friday Jan 2 - 1913

Light SE breeze and pleasant  
Finished cutting and started the  
try works at 11 AM Pumps and  
lights attended to So ended this day

66 Sat Jan 3 - 1913

Moderate SE breeze. All work boiling  
Vessel Cruising. Saw Humpbacks.  
Pumps and lights attended to. Sunshut  
boiling at 6 PM So ended

67 Sunday Jan 4 - 1913

Moderate East breeze. Vessel Cruising  
Saw Humpback. Finished Stowing  
down 68 Barrels of Sperm  
Pumps and lights attended to So ended  
Lat  $20^{\circ}42' N$   
Long  $26^{\circ}06' W$

68 Monday Jan 5 - 1913

Moderate NE Trades Clear and pleasant  
Vessel Cruising Saw Sperm Pumps  
and lights attended to So ended this day  
Lat  $19^{\circ}42' N$   
Long  $25^{\circ}52' W$

69 Tuesday Jan 6 - 1913

Moderate NE Trades and Cloudy  
Vessel Cruising for whales Pumps and  
lights attended to. So ended this day  
Lat  $19^{\circ}10' N$   
Long  $25^{\circ}44' W$

70 Wed Jan 7 - 1913

Moderate NE Trades. Thick hazy weather  
Vessel Cruising Pumps and lights attended  
to So ended this day.  
Lat  $17^{\circ}28' N$   
Long  $25^{\circ}01' W$
