

71 Thure Jan 8 - 1914

Moderate NE trades. Sperm whales were raised at 9 AM by Mr Martin. The whales were going quick to NNE. Lowered three boats WB & S Boat each caught one. Got the last whale along side at 3 PM. Commenced cutting in at 4 PM. Cut in one whale and left the other alongside all night. Pumps and lights attended to so ends this day. Lat 18° 08' N Long 25° 22' W

72 Friday Jan 9 - 1914

Begins with moderate trades. Cut in the whale and commenced boiling at 10.30 AM. Latter part very light breeze from ENE. Island of St Antoine in sight. Pumps and lights attended to so ends. Lat 17° 34' N Long 25° 29' W

73 Sat Jan 10 - 1914

Light NE trades. Sperm whales were raised by Manuel Andrade at 9 AM. Lowered LB & Starboard Boats at 10 AM. Each boat caught one. Got the last one alongside at 1.30 PM. Finished cutting in at Sundown. Pumps and lights attended to so ends this day. Lat 18° 08' N Long 26° 08' W

74 Sunday Jan 11 - 14

Very light breeze from NNE. Sperm Whales were raised at 2 PM by Manuel Rosairo. Lowered the LB & SB. SB caught one. Got the whale alongside at 8 PM. Left the whale alongside all night. Pumps and lights attended to so ends this day. Lat 18° 00' N Long 26° 19' W

75 Monday Jan 12 - 1914

Moderate breeze from NNE. Cut in the whale and commenced boiling at 9 AM. Finished at 9 PM. Pumps and lights attended to so ends. Lat 17° 42' N Long 26° 36' W

76 Tuesday Jan 13 - 14

Fresh breeze from NE. Finished Stowing down 120 bbls of Sperm oil. Pumps and lights attended to. Manuel Rosairo cut his wrist with a lance. So ends this day. Lat 17° 03' N Long 25° 49' W

77 Wed Jan 14 - 14

Fresh NE trades. Saw many Black-fish and Porpoise and Dolphin. Watch washing clothes. Pumps and lights attended to so ends. Lat 18° 02' N Long 26° 32' W
