

Sat May 2nd 1914

At Anchor at St. Gustatius
Took our Anchor at 4 P.M.
And shaped our course for Sombiero
Wind very light and from the S.E.
Schr mistie in sight. Vessel
taking about 2,500 strokes in
24 hours. So ends this day

Sunday May 3

Very light S.E. breeze with thick
cloudy weather. Passed Sombiero
Island at 3 P.M. So ends this day

Monday May 4

Clear and pleasant with light
N.E. Wind. Vessel taking quite fast
Lat 19° 54' N
Long 63° 02' W

Tues May 5 - 1914

Light northerly breeze with thick
cloudy weather. Pumps and
lights attended to. So ends this day
No Obs

Wed May 6 - 14

Moderate N.E. breeze with clear
weather. Vessel taking 3000
strokes in 24 hours. Bound
for Matinilla reef

Lat 22° 38'
Long 67° 50'

Thurs May 7 - 14

Very light northerly breeze. Watch employed
about the deck. Vessel taking about
1500 strokes an hour with one pump.
Pump Ship once in 2 hours
Steward sick with fever but not off duty
So ends this day Lat 22° 58' N
Long 68° 34' W

Friday May 8 - 14

Very clear and pleasant with light
N.E. breeze. Nothing in sight.
Steward still sick with fever
So ends this day Lat 23° 15' N
Long 69° 45' W

Sat May 9 - 14

Very clear and pleasant with light
S.W. wind. Watch employed
repairing sails. Pumps and lights
attended to. So ends this day
Lat 24° 40' N
Long 70° 39' W

Sunday May 10 - 14

Moderate N.E. breeze and cloudy
Watch employed repairing sails
Pumps and lights attended to
Steward better Lat 26° 25' N
Long 72° 20' W
