Tuesday February 24<sup>th</sup>

Com mander with strong breeze  
from S W Ship heading S W W  
Weather fair clear  
Place sea top mast at 10 o'clock  
& fore blue jacks Eight - 10 o'clock  
the night of wind from S W  
Latter part moderate breeze  
Course S W W all sail out  
No observation

Wednesday March 1<sup>st</sup> 1863

Com mander with strong breeze from  
N W & rain weather with  
steering S W by E & S Port took in  
ing sail & put the boat on upper  
At dusk took in Main Royal  
through the night & Latter part  
& Rainy Shortened sail at midnight  
& made it at day light

Thursday March 2<sup>nd</sup>

Com mander with strong breeze from  
the N W Course S E by E, at 10 o'clock  
winds changed suddenly to the S  
& blow a moderate gale Put the  
Ship under double reef top sails  
Sail & reef main sail at 6 o'clock  
more moderate made some  
Latter part Rugged beam &  
& at 10 o'clock all hands to shorten  
Sail blowing hard from the  
At noon quite moderate made  
the light sails
