Remarks on Board Barque Tamerlane N^o 11
September Thursday 28th

This day begins with light breeze from the N^o E ship steering S by E with all sail on the ship at 7 P M double reef the topsails
I wore ship headed S at 1 P M wore ship to gun at 5 P M made all sail & stand S by W thick weather nothing in sight the watch employed in ship duty

Lat by Obs 14.19 N Long 24.24 W
Friday 29th

This day begins with light breeze from the N^o E ship steering S by W Middle last part the more broke out weather fine pleasant weather the watch employed in fitting the boats rigging two sails in night Lat by Obs 15.00 N No Obs To Day

Saturday 30th

First part of this day begins with light breeze from the N^o E steering S Middle part the wind came out S E last part the same last part the ship headed S S W fine pleasant weather the men employed in fitting the rigging five sails in night caught 10 porpoise ship leaks 2.60 strokes this 24th SE

October 1st

This day begins with light breeze from the S S E ship heading S S W Middle last part calm & sails in sight the men employed in ship duty fine pleasant weather ship leaks 2.50 strokes this 24th hour

October Monday 2nd

This day begins with light air from the eastward ship steering S by E at 8 P M had to square tock in down to double reef topsail at 10 P M made all sail to gun last part fine pleasant weather fine sails in sight the watch employed in fitting the rigging Lat by Obs 9.47 N

Tuesday 3rd

First part of this day begins with light breeze from the eastward steering S by E Middle last part the same two sails in sight the watch employed in fitting the rigging fine pleasant weather

Lat by Obs 7.57 N Long 22.45 W
Wednesday 4th

This day begins with light breeze from the eastward ship steering S by E Middle last part fine sailing & squally the wind all to round the compass plenty of rain nothing in sight the watch employed in ship duty No Obs To Day

Thursday 5th

This day begins with calm & raining the wind all to round the compass when there is any the ship to trying to steer S Middle last part the same ship leaks 2.10 this 24th sails in sight the boat half the time it rains & the other half hot & noight & should to nigger the men employed in ship duty so ends this day
