October Saturday 21st The

This day begins with a strong breeze from the S E ship steering S by W at 5 P M ahead S by W with sail on the ship Misch & last part squally fitted the cutting blocks & broke out water & flour. 4 miles in sight ship leaks 2.20 this day

Sunday 22nd The

This day begins with a strong breeze from the S E ship steering S by W at 6 P M South reef the topsails Misch & last part moderate at daylight made all sail ship leaks 2.20 this day last part fine pleasant weather

Monday 23rd The

This day begins with a light breeze from the Eastward ship steering S W with all sail out Misch & last part strong breeze from the N E all hands employed in setting up the rigging four & half floor down water ship leaks 1.30 this day

Tuesday 24th The

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the S E ship steering S by W Misch & last part the same nothing in sight all hands on deck & setting up the rigging four & half ship leaks 2.40 this day

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October Wednesday 25th The

This day begins with a light breeze from the S E ship steering S W Misch & last part the same the watch employed in fitting the rigging fine pleasant weather ship leaks 2.10 this day

Thursday 26th The

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the Eastward ship steering S W by W Misch & last part strong breeze the watch employed in fitting the rigging & the cooper & setting up shanks ship leaks 2.20 this day sent down four royal yards

Friday 27th The

This day begins with a strong & breeze from the N E ship steering S W by W Misch & last part the same at 7 P M South reef the topsails & had wind on the men employed in ship duty

Lat by Obs 28.24 S

Saturday 28th The

This day begins with a light breeze from the W ship steering S W by W with all sail out Misch & last part owing to bad wind on from the south at 7 P M South reef the topsails ship leaks 2.20 this day one sail in sight the watch employed in ship duty
