Tuesday, 21st the

November This day commences with a light breeze from the north with a thick fog ship steered N.W. by W with all sail out broke out with four fables & stowed down empty last nothing in sight

Wednesday, 22nd the

This day commences with a light breeze from the N. steered N.W. by W till 10 P.M. then light with the main yard to back thick fog all the time the men employed in ship duty

Thursday, 23rd the

First part of this day begins with a light air from the South middle & last part a light breeze from the westward ship heading to the southward first part foggy last part clear the men employed in ship duty

Friday, 24th the

This day commences with a light breeze from the N. ship steering N.W. by W till 1 P.M. then steered N. at 5 P.M. saw two right whales at 4 P.M. heard the Labrador boat & the low boat struck on a hill on ice till dark & then put a bit him & broke out one large of bread 44.10. 58.00

Saturday, 25th the

This day begins with light air at sun rise saw right whales & three fin whale all day but could not get fast for the wind will ship working to the westward at sun set took in sail

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Sunday, 26th the

November This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. ship in distance tack though the day at 10 P.M. double reef the topsails last part moderate nothing in sight the men employed in ship duty

Monday, 27th the

First part of this day begins with a light air from the N. & ship steering N.W. by W & a thick fog last part clear at 5 P.M. saw three right whales & going quick to the westward last part a light breeze from the westward ship heading N.W. by W

Tuesday, 28th the

This day commences with a light breeze from the westward ship in distance tack & heading to the southward & westward fine pleasant weather at sun rise saw one whale & going quick to the N.W. & all sail on the ship the men employed in ship duty

Lat by Obs 39.36.5 N. Long 58.13.38

Wednesday, 29th the

This day begins with a light breeze from the north ship steering to the southward & westward till 12 P.M. then steered N.W. & at 1 P.M. saw two whales & going quick to the westward at 4 P.M. saw three boats & there then till 5 P.M. but the wind faster then the boats could go the wind W by N & the barque got the W. by N. fine pleasant weather
