Remarks on Board Barque Tarnier Lane 88
January Tuesday 2nd
This day begins with a light breeze
from the Eastward steering S W fine pleasant
weather sent down the fairsail as required
it is bent it is gone nothing in sight

Lat by Uh 46.33 S Long 58.24
Wednesday 3rd

This day begins with a light breeze
from the W W steering S W all sail on
the ship sent in the jib as fitted it is bent
it is gone a main top gansail is fitted it
is missing topmast staysail is fitted it
it is bent it is gone very times

Lat by Uh 46.57 S Long 59.51. W
Thursday 4th

This day commences with a strong
breeze from the S W ship steering S W
all sail on broke out by lack of oil out
of the fore hok as required it rising times
one sail in sight

Lat by Uh 48.40 S Long 63.10. W
Friday 5th

First part of this day begins with a
strong breeze from the S W steering S
W. A last part light breeze from
the S ship headed to board W fine pleasant
weather the men employed in ship
only nothing in sight all sail on
the ship that find no whales one
sick man.

Lat by Uh 49.40 S Long 64.48. W

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January Saturday 6th

First part of this day begins with a moderate
gale from the S W with fast the wind
broke out from the south ship working
to the south with double reef topmast last
part mizzen at 4 P M saw wright whales
at 4th board the barbed is went about is
starboard about the barbed boat got fast
starboard is the second mate kill him at about 7 P M
boat took him a long side is got ready for cutting
Whale. 8 Then got supper commence cutting at 8
Knight 8 M at 1 P M finish cutting the third the
Whale 95 time 12 7 P M heard of the deck though
the night

Lat by Uh 51.10 S Long 65.2. W
Sunday 7th

This day commences with a light breeze
from the Westward ship on S of June loss
through the day fine pleasant weather at 6
30 M started the work nothing in sight
broke out 32 inch lack of bread

Lat by Uh 51.30 S Long 64.48. W
Monday 8th

This day commences with a light breeze from
the ship heading to the westward under easy
sail & boiling fine pleasant weather nothing
in sight

Lat by Uh 51.26 S Long 64.45 W
Tuesday 9th

This day begins with a light wind & light
ship heading to the westward at 4 P M cool
down the work at 5 P M had a heavy squall
so that we took in all sail but 11 we resumed
topmast but clear it lasted 2 hours all hands
busy to work

Lat by Uh 51.15 S Long 65.36. W
