Thursday 1<sup>st</sup>

This day begins with a light breeze from the N.W. ship heading S. by E. all sail on fine pleasant weather the men employed in ship duty nothing in night.

Lat by Uh 31.20 S Long 75.21 W  
Monday 2<sup>nd</sup>

This day commences with a light breeze from the N.W. ship heading N.W. by E. all sail on fine pleasant weather broke out one lark of shales for the cooper to set up a run & making spinnaker a run & fitting the rigging to sails in night.

Lat by Uh 29.00 S Long 75.21 W  
Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup>

This day commences with a light breeze from the South steering N.W. by E. all sail on sent down the main top sail & bent a owl one on bent the four spencer & on bent the four stay sail & the left painted his boat a run & fitting the rigging fine pleasant weather.

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. ship steering W.S.W. all sail on the ship fine pleasant weather the men employed in fitting the rigging.

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering W.S.W. all sail on nothing in night the watch employed in fitting the rigging & the cooper & setting up shales.

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering W. by N. run rain squalls nothing in night the watch employed in fitting the rigging.

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering W.S.W. all sail on the ship broke out the after hole & stowed down a lot of lark & broke out the deck for the men & the rest of the time fitting the rigging fine pleasant weather.

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering W.S.W. all sail on the men employed in ship duty.

Monday 9<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.E. ship steering from W to S.W. run rain squalls all sail on the ship the men employed in fitting the rigging & making gun gear.

Lat by Uh 19.23 S Long 90.50 W  
Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>

Broke This day commences with a strong wind from the S.E. steering W. by N. run rain squalls broke out water & fill the but & fill three lark of with salt water & got out one lb of beef & the rest of the time fitting the rigging & making gun gear.
