

Remarks on Board *Buque Tamerlane* 1866
May
Friday, 12th

This day commenced with a strong breeze from the N.E. ship steered N by N till daylight
then steered W at 6 P.M. saw land 3 points forward the sea beam 50 miles of at daylight saw make 3 points of the barbed bow 30 miles of then made land there for Honolulu at 6 P.M. the left took the bow boat & went to shore & sent the boat back & sent of one quarter of meat & the ship laid of a fine pleasant weather

Lat. N. 21.33. N. Long 157.55. W
Saturday, 13th

This day commenced with fine pleasant weather ship laying of a horn Honolulu & waiting for the left at 11 P.M. sent to boat to shore for the left at 1 P.M. the left came of a fine pleasant weather

Long 158.00. W

Sunday, 14th

This day begins with a strong breeze from the N.E. ship steered N W by N till daylight
then steered N W till 7 P.M. then steered W at 6 P.M. saw land 6 points of the barbed bow 85 miles of all sail on middle part squally land part fine this day the old saw had 10 days the men employed in ship duty

Monday, 15th

This day begins with a strong breeze from the N.E. ship steered N S W till daylight
then steered W at 7 P.M. saw land island of the barbed beam this day the men employed in mending the old rig of the foremast after four sent the other down & had the other fine weather

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May
Tuesday, 12th

First part of this day begins with a strong breeze from the N.E. ship steered N by N
then squally land part fine pleasant weather broke out broad a flow to pad sea on
Lat. N. 25.11 N Long 165.46. W
Wednesday, 13th

This day commences with a strong breeze from the Eastward ship steered N W by W
lookin the bow boat & sent out the men one sent down the plank & took out four boats & fitted it & sent it to game broke out & had a fine pleasant weather
Lat. N. 26.09 N Long
Thursday, 14th

This day begins with a light breeze from the Eastward ship steering N W by W fine pleasant weather fixin the old bow boat rose new four shaft reef tacks
Lat. N. 28.06 N Long 169.39. W
Friday, 15th

This day commences with a light breeze from the N.E. middle & land part the same ship steered N W. W fine pleasant weather painted the old bow boat plenty of work to going on but no whales

Lat. N. 29.45 N Long 170.04. W

Saturday, 16th

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the north middle part the same
but land part the wind haul to the N W
rain rain ship steered N W by W 18 hours
then sent N W by N kill one fog 90.
the men employed in ship duty
