

Remarks on board barque *Turner Lane* 1866

Monday 18th

First part of this day commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. steering N.W. by W. thick weather the light sails in Middle part make Middle part the wind came and North at 11 A.M. Tack ship to the westward last part double reef st. part middle & last part clear nothing in sight the men employed in ship duty

Lat. by Ch. 62.48. N Long 175.22. W

Tuesday 19th

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the north ship heading to land W at 5 P.M. Tack ship to the eastward all sail on the ship Middle & last part the same & land haul the time foggy nothing in sight the men employed in ship duty

Lat by Ch. 62.41. N no long to day

Wednesday 20th

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the eastward ship heading to land north all sail on the ship Middle find the wind haul to the westward at 11 P.M. Tack ship to the north & steer N.W. & fine weather all sail on the ship sent down the main st. part & fited it & bent it & sent in the fly jib & bent it & gave this is what I call to let job saint Lawrence island in sight it bare N 90 miles of some of such in sight

Thursday 21st

This day commences with a light breeze from the N middle part later sent in the job & fited it & bent it & gave the main haul & it Lawrence island in sight but no wind and seen no how heads yet but I am in hope that we will in a few days

Lat by Ch. 62.27 N Long 171.12. W

Remarks on board barque *Turner Lane* of new 1866

Friday 22nd

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the westward steer north & long wind Lawrence island at 5 P.M. saw four ships & doing nothing at 11 P.M. the natives came on board & kept 2.48 Middle part thick & laid to back last part calm the ship 10 miles of it Lawrence island to the N.W. land got the ship no more haul up the back haul & got the anchor of the bow being times & trading

No Ch. To Day

Saturday 23rd

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the eastward middle & last part the same ship heading to land north fine pleasant weather 7 ships in sight & one boiling & the rest doing nothing the ship & land one quarter way from it Lawrence island & the main this day we gave with the middle left 11 hours 7 P.M. land time

No Ch. To Day

Sunday 24th

First part of this day begins with a strong breeze from the N.W. ship heading N.W. by W Middle & last part thick fog middle part ship under double reef st. part at 7 P.M. sent all sail on ship & beating to the southward land in sight once & whale 10 given this day with hard luck

Monday 25th

First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the N.W. the ship & beating to the N.W. in a thick fog Middle & last part the same saw two ships one boiling & the other & beating to the N.W.
