Tuesday Jan 15th 1867
 com with strong wind from NE & Pleasant
 heading NNE under all sail by the wind
 employed repairing main top sail latter part wind
 NE with squalls wind & rain heading NNE took
 in light sails

Wednesday Jan 16th
 first part strong winds from NE till 3 PM then
 haul to NNE more ship to the eastward finished
 main top sail heavy squalls wind & rain with
 thunder & lightning latter part wind from NE weather
 fine heading ESE under all sail Lat 11:47
 Long 143:54

Thursday Jan 17th
 begins with strong breeze from NE & Pleasant
 heading ESE by the wind under all sail
 employed at various jobs latter part small breeze
 from NW heading SE employed in ship duty

Friday Jan 18th
 three 1/2 hours begins with Pleasant breeze from
 NW weather fine heading SE at 3 PM saw
 Black Fish lowered Boat Mast & Boom Brats get
 2 latter part small breeze from NE with fine
 weather heading ESE hoisted out 2 Black Fish

Saturday Jan 19th
 com with light air from NE & Pleasant heading ESE
 employed cleaning masts latter part light
 baffling winds course NE by N weather fine

Sunday Jan 20th 1867
 first part gentle breeze from NE course W by N under
 sail weather fine ship under all sail latter part
 changeable winds & plenty of rain course NE

Monday Jan 21st
 com with changeable winds & rainy weather course
 NE latter part wind from NE with
 heavy squalls wind & rain heading ESE
 Lat 13:25
 Long 140:48

Tuesday Jan 22nd
 com with strong winds from N with
 squally weather heading ESE employed
 in ship duty at 7 PM took in sail
 to double reefed top sails & covered
 latter part wind from NNE to NE
 with fine weather heading ESE
 made all sail Lat 14:54
 Long 139:38

Wednesday Jan 23rd
 begins with moderate breeze from
 NE heading ESE under all sail
 employed in ship duty at 8 PM
 move ship to the Northward
 latter part the same

Thursday Jan 24th
 com with fresh winds from NE heading
 NNE took in light sails. latter part
 wind the same move ship to the
 eastward unhook main sail
 com to repairing it so ends
