

Remarks on board Bark Fur

Monday Feb 11th 1853
First part strong wind from NE
with good weather heading on opposite
tacks under all sail Magdalena
in sight dist 30 miles at 4 PM
saw Daniel Wood at sun set
took in sail latter part wind &
weather the same at 6 PM made
sail cruising off Magdalena I saw
vessel in sight

Tuesday Feb 12th
these 24 hours begins with strong
breezes from NE cruising off
Magdalena I saw employed in
ship duty at sun set shorten
sail lying Head yards a back heading
to the SE latter part wind & weather
the same at 6 PM made all sail
at 8 PM saw Hales lowered boats
saw three more afterwards came
on board steering different courses
Magdalena I saw in sight dist
12 leagues bearing NNE at sun set
shorten sail

Wednesday Feb 13th
begins with strong breezes from NE weather
good heading on opposite tacks at
sun set shorten sail latter part
wind & weather the same at 6 PM
made all sail heading opposite tacks
Magdalena I saw 16 leagues
dist at 11 AM saw Whales stary
for them

Merlane of New Bedford

Thursday Feb 14th 1853
First part wind from NE weather
good heading on opposite tacks
at noon lowered boats & boats
at 4 PM took them all along
side at 4 PM get ready to
come & cut one get super
at them to cut to morrow latter
part wind & weather the same
at 10 PM finished
cutting so ends

Friday Feb 15th
begins with strong wind from
heading SE under top sails
employed clearing away heads
saw hoisting latter part wind from
NE heading N employed hoisting
ship of under all sail

Saturday Feb 16th
corn with moderate wind from NE by
heading N by the wind employed
hoisting latter part wind & weather
the same heading on opposite
tacks

Sunday Feb 17th
corn with gentle breezes from
NE weather fine heading SE
under all sail at 6 PM finished
hoisting Leone on duty latter
part wind & weather the same
Magdalena I saw in sight
bearing N
