

Remarks on board Barque

Sunday Apr 14th 1869
These 24 hours begins with
calm get some fresh Beef &
Two sacks potatoes smoked Ship

Monday Apr 15th
Calm with sea breeze painted to
Day before Capitan & Marengo
came in to anchor

Tuesday Apr 16th
begins with wind S.W. get off
242 sacks of Potatoes all ready
for sea

Wednesday Apr 17th
Calm waiting for a land breeze
Latter part at 3 P.M. get under
way under all sail steering W.N.W.
Till 8 A.M. wind left at 10 P.M.
get small breeze from S.W. course
E.N.E. in Quince Channel going to
Northward of Mauee to Honolulu

Thursday Apr 18th
Calm with calm till 7 P.M. then
a breeze from S.E. course E.N.E. last
part of Mauee bore N. dist 20 miles
Latter part light baffling wind &
cloudy I Mauee in sight course N.E.

Friday Apr 19th
Calm with small breeze from
S.E. I Mauee East point bore S.W.
course N.W. by N. latter part small
breeze from S.W. course N.W. East part

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Mauee bore S.W. dist 25 miles
so ends

Saturday Apr 20th 1869
Calm with calm heavy swell from N.
at 2 P.M. get strong wind
from N.E. course W. took in light
sails for a while then more
moderate at the again
at 5 P.M. course W. S.W. Morotoi in
sight Borend to calm at latter part
strong wind from N.E. course W. S.W. Till
2 P.M. then haul by wind aback till
3 P.M. then kept off S.W. calm in sight
at 8 P.M. got off Honolulu Capt went on
shore ship off & on a

Sunday Apr 21st
wind the same off & on at 5 P.M.
Capt came off stud in for anchorage
let go anchor and bottom bore anchor
up made sail made a tack run in
again took in sail no bottom
made sail fished anchor off & on
waiting for morning latter part
off & on at 9 A.M. came to anchor and
side reef in 16 fathoms water

Monday Apr 22nd
Calm with strong wind from
N.E. get mizen top mast
