of rain Benj. A. Paofit, John Slater  
Albert N. Johnson, John W. Wade  
Mr. H. C. Farrell are seamen that was ship  
in Honolulu and are on Board

Friday Apr 26

Strong winds from N.N.E. at 11 AM  
got under way set all sail Bound  
North at 12:30. At 1 PM double reefed  
fore top sails This day Ends at 11 PM

Saturday Apr 27

Strong winds from N.N.E. cloudy  
weather Ship by the wire to the  
light sails in middle and latter  
part moderate breezes at day light see  
Atori bearing N.W. 35 miles Dist.

Sunday Apr 28

Small breezes from E. Steered N by N  
at 7 PM One hour bore N.N.W.  
35 miles middle and latter part the  
same

Lat by obs 21° 36' N

Monday Apr 29 - 1867

Small breezes from N good weather  
Steering N by the wire all sail set  
at 7 PM. One hour bore S.W. 4 miles  
Dist middle part the same latter part  
pleasant breezes from E.N.E. Steered N  
busy stowing sperm oil

Tuesday Apr 30

moderate breezes from E.N.E. cloudy some  
rain Steered N busy stowing Oil middle  
part freshen on with rain took in light  
sails Antonio Palmedo off Duty with  
the Verrill latter part strong gales from  
S.E. to S.W. Steered N.N.W. stowed the  
main course double reefed fore top  
sail

Wednesday May 1

Strong gales from S.W. to W. cloudy  
weather Steered N.N.W. see two Barks  
Steering the same middle part the  
same latter part more moderate  
made sail according to weather

Thursday May 2

Moderate breezes from N Steered N by N  
at 2 PM wind veered to N.W. heave  
Ship off to N.N.E. middle and latter  
part the same finished stowing Oil  
See two Ship's Steering the same

Friday May 3

pleasant breezes from N.N.W. good  
weather Ship by the wire to the N.E.  
middle and latter part the  
same Ship on different tack  
See a Ship to the Seward
