Tuesday May 14 - 1867

Brisk gales from N.W. attended with
squalls ship heeled N by E middle
part the same latter part strong
breezes from N.W. Steered N by E
Lat By Obs $38^{\circ} 53' N$

Wednesday May 15

Brisk gales from S.W. cloudy weather,
steered N.W. by N at 4 P.M. double
reefed topsails middle part the same
latter part moderating with rain
made sail according

Thursday May 16

moderate breezes from W to S.W.
Ship's course N.W. by N middle part
small breezes latter part fresh breezes

Long By Chron $160^{\circ} 54' W$

Friday May 17

Commenced with fresh breezes from
W to S.W. ship course N.W. by N
middle and latter part strong
breezes

Lat By Obs $45^{\circ} 46' N$

Long By Chron $161^{\circ} 21' W$

Saturday May 18

Brisk gales from S.W. stormy weather
steered N.W. by N middle part
the same latter part winds from N.W.
Ship By the wind on different tacks

Long By Chron $162^{\circ} 28' W$

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Sunday May 19 - 1867

Small breezes from N.W. ship weather
Ship By the wind to the N middle part
calms latter part fresh breezes from E.S.E.
set muddling sails

Lat By Obs $48^{\circ} 33' N$

Long By Chron $162^{\circ} 2' W$

Monday May 20

fresh breezes from E. cloudy weather, steered
N by W all sail set see one fin back
middle and latter part fresh breezes & stormy

Tuesday May 21

Strong breezes from E by N stormy weather
steered N at 6 P.M. double reefed fore top
sail continued the same throughout the day
hoisted

Wednesday May 22

fresh breezes from N.E. by E foggy at times
Ship on different tacks see several fin
back middle and latter part small breezes
busy at various jobs

Thursday May 23

Small baffling airs and calms hazy weather
middle and latter part the same

Friday May 24

Small airs and calms busy at various
jobs about the ship middle and latter
part fresh breezes and stormy
winds veering to N
