fresh breezes from N. thick foggy weather ship by the wind to N.E. at 2 P.M. double reefed top sails furled main course middle and latter part. Brisk gales from S ship on different tacks

Sunday May 26

At 10 A.M. brisk gales from S. N.E. light showers see Land of rain at 2 P.M. kept off N.W. see several fin backs middle part the same (being N.W.) latter part fine weather see several fin backs Dist 30 miles

Monday May 27

Small airs and calm cloudy weather ship heading to the Eastward middle part the same latter part pleasant breezes from South Steered East busy at various jobs about the ship

Tuesday May 28

pleasant breezes from E.S.E. ship by the wind Steered N.E. fine weather see several fin backs middle part the same latter part fresh on ship on different tacks

Wednesday May 29

Brisk gales from N.N.E. cloudy weather ship on different tacks at 4 P.M. double reefed see several fin backs middle and latter part strong gales drove ship to under the storm sail Steered N.E.

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Thursday May 30 - 1867

Brisk gales from W and moderating ship by the wind to the N at 2 P.M. kept off E by S under double reef middle and latter part the same at 4 P.M. kept off E.N.E. see a few fin backs

Long By Chron $154^{\circ} 53' W$

Friday May 31

fresh breezes from W.S.W. pleasant weather Steered E by N at 6 P.M. came in squally drove by the wind to the on different tacks at 4 P.M. kept off E by N set all sail munt fore sail fore top sail bent others

Saturday June 1

pleasant breezes from N.E. fine weather Steered N.E. all sail set continued the same through out these 24 hours

Sunday June 2

small breezes from N to N.W. good weather Steered N.E. repaired fifth middle and latter part the same

Monday June 3

Small breezes from N.W. variable weather Steered N.E. all sail set middle and latter part calm

Tuesday June 4

Calm small airs fine weather busy repairing fore sail middle and latter part the same finished the new fore sail stowed it below bent the old one
