Small breezes from W to WNW fine weather
Ship by the wind to the NNE at 6:30 P.M.
tacked ship heading SW by W at 11 P.M.
wind veered to NW & tacked ship heading
N.W. latter part the same

Long By Chr. $120^{\circ} 23' W$

Saturday July 13

Fresh breezes from S.W. to WNW
Ship by the wind head up N.W. off
N. See a number of fin backs
midell part the same at 12 M. tacked
ship heading S by W at 3 A.M. tacked again heading
N.W. weather thick at times at 3 A.M.
tacked ship see land bearing N.E. 30 miles
latter part thick fog with rain

Sunday July 14

Small air and calms thick fog at 8 P.M.
fog lit up land close to 15 miles Dist.
midell and latter part small breezes from
N.E. Steered S.W. along the land

Monday July 15

Small breezes from N.E. to W
fine weather Ship by the wind heading
W off S & W midell and latter part
the same at 8 A.M. tacked heading
W by N & W

Tuesday July 16. 1867

fresh breezes from S.W. to W & W heavy
weather Ship by the wind head up W by S
off N.W. see several hump backs
midell part Steered S.E. at 6 A.M. tacked
heading W by N

Wednesday July 17

fresh breezes from S to S.E. cloudy weather
see a number of fin backs & hump backs
at 4 P.M. midell part S. fore N 10 miles
Ship course S.W. brisk gales through the
night at 1 A.M. hove to under a double
reefed main top sail at 7 A.M. wore ship
steered S.W. at 11 A.M. see the main land bearing
N.W. moderating made sail according to
weather

Long $129^{\circ} 57' W$

Thursday July 18

pleasant breezes from N.W. and veered
to W & W head ship off to S set all sail
midell part brisk gales double reefed top
sails furled the main sail ship on different
tacks latter part moderating made sail according

Friday July 19

Small breezes from W fine weather Ship
by the wind head S.S.W. S.W. working in to
Cook's Inlet midell part calm latter part
fresh breezes see Roadsack Is. ahead see several
