passed 15 miles from the Is. made no stop see  
nothing but hump backs at 7 P.M. the S.W.  
Point of the Is. bore S. S. W. 15 miles middle  
part and latter small air ship on different  
tacks throughout the night.

Sunday July 21

calms small air ships course & weather  
fine see several hump backs at 5 P.M. got  
a small breeze from N. N. W. at 1 P.M. the S.W.  
Point of the Is. bore S. W. 20 miles middle and  
latter part fresh breezes.

Monday July 22

fresh breezes from W. clear weather ship  
by the wind to the S. S. W. middle and latter  
part breezes about the same latter part fog  
busy stowing salt water.

Tuesday July 23

fresh breezes from W. S. S. W. foggy weather ship by  
the wind heading S. S. S. by C. all sail set  
at 1 P.M. took the wind from S. S. S. W.  
tacked ship head W up S. W. by W at times thick  
what fog busy stowing salt water in  
after hatch.

pleasant breezes from S. foggy weather ship by  
the wind to the W. S. W. see several fin back  
Whales continued the same throughout these  
24 hours ship on different tacks.

Thursday July 25

fresh breezes from S. W. clear weather ship  
by the wind on different tacks working  
West middle and latter part the same.

Friday July 26

fresh breezes from S. W. heavy weather ship  
by the wind on different tacks working W.  
at 3 P.M. see Choumagin Is. bearing S. W.  
15 miles continued the same throughout  
these 24 hours at 8 P.M. see a schooner  
to the Westward.

Saturday July 27

fresh breezes from S. S. W. cloudy weather  
ship on different tacks working W at 6 P.  
M. Capt. went on board of the above schooner  
Amanahci Ager of San Francisco head fishing  
had done very well the above Is. bearing N. W.  
by 12 miles middle and latter part the  
same small air from N. W. stored  
W. S. W. bent a new main sail.
