weather fine middle part calms latter part
same as fore part

Monday July 29

Small breezes from NW fine weather
Steered N by S at 3 PM see Halibut
S. bearing NW by N Dist. 20 miles also
Commish. bearing NW W 50 miles

See several fin Backs middle part
wind freshened on double reefed at 10
At 10 commenced to moderate made sail
According

Tuesday July 30

fresh breezes from NW to N W
fine weather Ship by the wind head
S W at 4 PM ~~the ship~~ head N
& N N E middle and latter part the same
Ship on different tack working up to the
Passages

Wednesday July 31

fresh breezes from W fine weather Ship by the
wind working up to Commish. Passage at 6 AM
Drawn in to the Passages see several hump backs
middle and latter part moderate breezes at 2 PM
No wind hauler to S W Steered N & by N

Thursday Aug 1

moderate breezes from S to S E stormy weather
Steered N at 6 PM Commish. S. bore S E
30 miles middle part the same latter
part brisk gales from W Ship by
the wind head N N W

Bark Samerlane, Cruising in Bristol Bay
Friday Aug 2 - 1867

Strong gales from W. Squally at times
Ship drove to under her Green Sail,
head N N W continued the same through
out these 24 hours

Saturday Aug 3

Strong gales from W stormy weather Ship
dove to on harbour tack head N N W
at 6 P.M. more Ship head S & W rounded got
Bottom in 23 fathoms middle part the
same latter part more moderate made sail
according to weather

Sunday Aug 4

Strong breezes from W foggy weather
Ship by the wind head S & S by W
at 7 PM see a sail a large green Brig
Kobala from Arctic & Wheeler latter part
weather much the same same the Brig
sold her four barrels of meat two of each
kind & keg of butter

Monday Aug 5

fresh breezes from W foggy weather
Ship by the wind head S & W at 3 PM
kept off S.E. by E. the Brig in company
middle and latter part the same Ship
on different tack Cruising see several
hump backs at 7 PM see Smak. S. bearing
East 10 miles

Tuesday Aug 6

fresh breezes from W Sandy weather Ship
by the wind on different tack Cruising
at 6 PM shortened sail middle and
latter part the same
