Thursday Aug 8

Small breezes from S to foggy weather
Ship by the wind head N N W hauler
Caught some cod fish mussels and other
part stormy weather

Friday Aug 9

Small breezes from W to thick fog ship
by the wind head N N W middle and
latter part about the same

Saturday Aug 10

Small airs from S to S W foggy weather
Ship by the wind head N N W caught a few
cod fish at 8 P M Tacked ship head S W
latter part much the same as fore part

Sunday Aug 11

Small breezes from W to W N W thick
fog ship by the wind head S. S. W at 4 P M
cleared off fine at 7 P M see a Brig to windward
Continued the same throughout these 24 hours
at 7 A M Tacked ship head S W

Monday Aug 12

fresh breezes from W S W to W N W foggy at
times ship by the wind on different tacks
working West middle part fresh breezes
latter part moderate breezes good weather
See a Brig to the Westward

Tuesday Aug 13 - 1867

pleasant breezes from W and over gradually to S
E stormy weather at 1 P M. Tacked ship head
W S W by W the Brig in sight to the W
Ship on different tacks through the night
latter part fine weather Steered S W

Long By Chron $163^{\circ} 42' W$

Wednesday Aug 14

pleasant breezes from W N W fine weather
Steered S W at 1 P M Steered S by E. at 3 P M
South at 8 P M sighted St. Pauls Is. bearing
S by E 20 miles middle and latter part
fresh breezes from S head a new fore top
sail & main top sail see several fine
Barks

Thursday Aug 15

Brisk gales from S stormy weather ship by
the wind to the W S W up W S W continued
the same throughout the 24 hours at 11 A M saw
ship head S by W

Friday Aug 16

Brisk gales from W thick stormy weather
Ship head to the S S W under double reefes
and courses middle and latter part the
same at 10 A M recd a Brig to windward
Steering S E kept off & steered the same

Saturday Aug 17

Strong breezes from W N W variable weather
Steered S E at 2 P M see St. Pauls Is.
ahead passed close to it at 6 P M hauled
to the wind head S W middle part the
same latter part fine at 11 A M see
right Whales the S. bearing S E 20 miles
lowered without success Come on board
and stood to the North the Brig in sight
