Small breezes from N.W. S.W. good
weather plenty of right Whales see
the Oliver Croaker Strack one we
Lowered without success middle
and latter part the same see Emily
Margen take a whale at 11 A.M.
Le. Boat went on did not get fast
this I differant chances I have given
my Boat steere got fast to five

Sunday Sept. 15

fresh Breezes from N.N.E. Ship on
different tacks Boats off most of
the chasing without success
at 11 P.M. St. George Bore E by S 15 miles
St. Pauls bore N.N.E. the same Dist
Strong gales throughout these
24 hours

Strong gales from N.N.E. attended
with frequent squalls of rain Ship hove
to under her storm sails ahead E 8
N.W. by N see two Barks hove to
Continued the same throughout these
24 hours

Tuesday Sept. 17

Strong gales from N.W. cloudy weather
Ship hove to under her storm sails
ahead N.N.E. midnight the gale broke
latter part fine fresh breezes from
N.N.W.

Wednesday Sept. 18

fresh breezes from N fine weather
Ship by the wind standing in between
the Is. at 1 P.M. see one right whale
lowered Le. Boat got fast at 4 P.M.
got the whale to the Ship commenced
cutting at 1 A.M. all in St. George bore
E 8 E 15 miles then middle and
latter part fine busy boiling Lowered
two Boats for whales without success

Thursday Sept. 19

pleasant breezes from N fine weather
Ship on different tacks busy boiling
four Barks in sight see one strack
a whale see several whales long Dist. of
to windward middle and latter part
the same see one right whale
going N quick lowered for him
without success
