

Bark James Lane Cruising Off St. Pauls
 Friday Sept 20 - 1867
 Lowered for whale Small breezes from N E fine weather
 all four boats ship on different tacks closing in
 with the land busy boiling four Barks
 in sight one cutting one whaling
 on Board middle and latter part the same

Saturday Sept 21
 Small breezes from N good weather
 ship by the wind head E at 2 PM
 lowered for whale going quick to windward
 no chance come on Board at 7 PM ship
 E by N 15 miles were ship head N
 Continued the same at 12 M in night took
 down at 1 AM broke out to snow down

Sunday Sept 22
 Fresh breezes from N N W cloudy weather
 ship by the wind on different tacks
 busy plowing down at 7 PM
 finished 145 who same time (the
 ship bore N E by N 15 miles latter part
 the same steered S E four Barks
 in sight one boiling one chasing

Monday Sept 23
 light breezes from N N W to N E good
 weather steering S E. at 7 PM shortening
 sail hauled to by the wind head
 N W St. Georges Is. bore N E 20 Dist
 middle and latter part the same

Bark James Lane Cruising Off St. Pauls
 Tuesday Sept 24 - 1867
 Brisk gales from E by N Cloudy
 weather ship on different tacks
 see one right whale so rough did
 not lower at 6 PM close reefed top
 sails were ship head N E. St. Pauls
 bore N by W 12 miles middle and
 latter part strong gales

Wednesday Sept 25
 Strong gales from E N E stormy weather
 ship drove to under her storm sails
 head up S E off S. S. C. at 3 PM. were ship
 head N continued the same throughout
 these 24 hours

Thursday Sept 26
 Strong gales from N N E ship bore
 to under her storm sails head N N W
 middle and latter part more moderate
 were ship head N N E made sail
 according to weather Lat by Obs 56° 16' N
 Long 172° 11' W

Friday Sept 27
 Brisk gales from W N W cloudy
 weather steered N E middle latter part
 fine weather at 6 AM kept off and
 steered N E. at 11.30 AM see land
 St. Pauls ahead same time see one right
 whale
