Saturday Sept. 28. 1867

Pleasant breeze from W. Ship by the
wind to the N at 1 P M lowered for
the whale. Boat got fast at 7 P M
got the whale along side midall and
latter part fine at 6 A M commenced
cutting see three ship and boiling
see and right whale going quick

Sunday Sept. 29

Calms small baffling airs busy cutting
at 6 A M finished started boiling midall
and latter part fresh breezes from E S E
Ship on different tacks 6 Ship in sight
saw two Casks of Grease gauging 320
Gallons to the French Ship Harmon

Monday Sept. 30

Strong breeze from E S E cloudy weather
Ship on different tacks close in with
St. Pauls Is. bearing N E see two ships
Boats fast continued the same throughout
these 24 hours

Tuesday Oct. 1

Pleasant breezes from S fine weather
busy boiling Ship on different tacks
four ships in sight at 7 P M
the Is bore N N E 15 miles
Continued the same busy boiling &
stowing Oil in fore hold hauled
the Bark Emily Morgan Capt. got
quit goly

Wednesday Oct. 2 - 1867

Brisk gale from S Stormy at times
busy at taking care of Oil Ship on
different tacks Continued the same
throughout these 24 hours

Thursday Oct. 3

fresh breezes from S S W cloudy
weather breeze to the N E E see four
ships to the Eastward one boiling
midall and latter part fresh breezes
busy stowing Oil see one ship cutting
and boiling

Friday Oct. 4

fresh breezes from S S W good weather
Ship on different tacks close in
with the Is at 7 P M finished
stowing Oil whale two hundred and
ninety barrels midall and latter
part small airs and calms

Saturday Oct. 5

fresh breezes from E cloudy weather
Ship by the wind to the S E see
Ship Gay Hoar struck a whale five
in sight hauled Ship Three Brothers
17 Whales midall and latter part strong
gale Ship hove to under the storm sails
beaching S W one tack E by N on
the other
