Bris. gales from N.E. squally weather
Steered S by E at 6 P.M. double reef
midell and latter part the same

Saturday Oct. 19

Bris. gales from N.E. squally
weather Steered S.E. busy scraping
ship midell and latter part moderate
breezes at day light see a ship ahead that
we passed on in the night

Pleasant N.E. trades fine sea the Steered
S.E. midell and latter part the
same see a ship to windward

Monday Oct. 21

Steered S.E. continued the same

Lat By Obs $23^{\circ} 15' N$
Long $155^{\circ} 38' W$

Tuesday Oct. 22

Strong N.E. trades pleasant weather
Steered S.E. busy at various jobs at 2 P.M.
we kept off S by W midell and latter
part the same at 6 P.M. raised anchor
at 4 P.M. came to anchor Lookinai

Small baffling airs fine weather
busy drying bone took on board two
quarters of Beef Eight Bags of Potatoes

Thursday Oct. 24

Pleasant breezes from N.E. good weather
busy drying and bundling bone sent
on shore seven teen empty barrels took
onboard two kegs of sugar two barrels of
rice one keg of Butter one bag of Coffee
two Bags of rice
