

Bark Tamerlane In The Sandwich Is.

Friday Oct. 25 - 1867

Strong N.E. Trades fine weather busy
at various jobs took on board thirteen
barrels of meat 20 of Sweet Potatoes
Six Shapp's some fifty Pumping at 6
P.M. took our anchor and went to sea

Saturday Oct. 26

Strong N.E. trades at 11 A.M. came
to anchor in Honolulu Harbour
about all hands being cruises went
on shore

Sunday Oct. 27

fresh N.E. Trades good weather

Monday Oct. 28

pleasant weather small trades Discharged
and pay off the sailors sent down main
top gallant yard to have a new one made
Discharged 21 men four officers
and seventeen men

So ends

Tuesday Oct 29th 1867

Fine weather light
trades Discharged the Cook sick
to the Hospital

Wednesday Oct 30

These 24 hours fine
weather nothing new
So ends

Thursday Oct 31st 1867

Commences and
continues fine weather
So Ends

Friday November 1st 1867

These 24 hours fine
trade winds ships coming into
port So Ends

Saturday Novem 2^d 1867

Begins and ends
with variable winds and weather
showers of rain
So Ends

Sunday Novem 3^d 1867

These 24 hours
the same as the last
So Ends

Monday Novem 4th 1867

Begins and ends
with showers of rain ships
coming in So Ends

Tuesday Novem 5th 1867

These 24 hours
light trades and fine weather
ships coming in to harbor
So Ends
