Tuesday Novem 12<sup>th</sup> 1867

These 24 hours fine

4 men wither employed 4 men took  
on board our Bread and Stoves  
one of the crew missing by the  
name of William H. Cudds his things all  
gone So Ends

Wednesday Novem 13<sup>th</sup> 1867

Begins and ends

with light westerly winds  
nothing doing Cudds still missing  
So Ends

Thursday Novem 14<sup>th</sup> 1867

Commences and

ends with fine with our  
man Cudds still missing Shipped  
one man name Ganselues  
who failed to come on board  
So Ends
